


Preparation

- 1. Attach desired header to the combine. Lock the head to the combine.
- 2. Raise the head off the ground and lower the safety stop on the feeder house cylinder.
- 3. Set the parking brake on the combine.
- 4. Turn off the combine engine and remove the key.

Refer to Figure 1.1—1.3

- 1.1 Install one mount (LANSS7B01) as shown below. On 2012 and newer heads you may have to cut two holes through the back sheet metal using the 1-3/8" hole saw (LANFCJ9MC) to install the U-Bolts. Do not tighten at this time.
- 1.2 Install one mount (LANSS7B01) as far out on each end of the header frame as possible it should be in line with or just to the side of the fourth row from the outside on these headers. Do not tighten at this time.



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NOTE: Some headers will have existing hardware that can be used to attach the end mounts.

Refer to Figure 1.4

1.3 Locate 2 holes on the vertical end sheets on the right side of the header that align with the Toolbar End Mount (LANSS7B06). Drill these holes out using a 1/2" Drill Bit (LANFH492F).

1.4 Attach the Toolbar End Mount (LANSS7B06). Repeat on other end of header with the LANSS7B06M. Do not tighten at this time.



NOTE: Some headers will have existing hardware that can be used to attach the mount supports to the header.


FIGURE 1.6A SHOWS RIGHT END OF HEADER

1.5 Install end mount support (LANSS650EBL) on left end of header and end mount support (LANSS650EBR) on right end of header. Do not tighten at this time. *Hardware:*

Note: Use hardware on head to hang bracket and supplied hardware to connect it to LANSS7B06.

1.5 Install end mount supports (LANSS7B07). Do not tighten at this time.

1.6 Attach the channel (LANSS7B07) to the main bracket (LANSS7B06 & LANSS7B06M) on each side.

1.7 Tighten all hardware on the end mounts.

2.1 Attach the rotating toolbar mounts (bar side brackets) (LANSS7B05) to the previously installed head mounts on each side of header. Make sure it is oriented as shown in Figure 2.1.



For 20" Rows: On one end of each LANSS6570 toolbar, cut 2.5" off. This end will mesh with the LANSS650TCB bracket.




2.2 Attach the toolbar connecting bracket (LANSS650TCB) between two welded toolbars (LANSS6570) making sure the zinc plated tubes are spaced 22" apart. Bolt the tubes to the rotating toolbar mounts (LANSS7B05) as shown in Figure 2.3. When the LANSS7B05 brackets are horizontal, the zinc plated tubes in the LANSS6570 should be horizontal and face away from the header. Tighten U-Bolts on toolbar first, make sure the toolbar swings freely, then tighten hardware on header mounts.

NOTE: On both the left and right side of the header, make sure no part of the toolbar extends past the outside edge of the outer rotating toolbar mounts (LANSS7B05)! - See Figure 2.3


2.3 Install the flip up head mounts to the rows just to the right and left of the feeder house opening.

All parts, hardware and instructions can be found in the LANSS6X kit.

3. Mount Hydraulic Cylinders

Refer to Figure 3.1 & 3.2.

3.1 Loosely mount the cylinder mount brackets (LANSS7B04) on both sides of the header to the toolbar as shown. One needs to be between the second and third row from the outside of the header. The other needs to be roughly 48"-62" inside of the outside mount. Make sure the hydraulic cylinder will have clearance from the driveshaft at the location you choose.

Hardware:

8 LAN600UBOLT U-Bolt 5/8"x2.6"x3.7" 16 LAN690830 5/8" Serrated Flange Nut

3.2 Mark and drill two holes in line with the LANSS7B04 bracket through the sheet metal using the supplied 3/4" Hole Saw (LANFCJ9M0) on each side of header.



3. Mount Hydraulic Cylinders

Refer to Figure 3.3

3.3 If the top beam of your head is an open channel, slide Cylinder Mount-Head Side Reinforcement (LANSS650HH2) into the channel. This reinforcement simply "squeezes" between the channel, no bolt will go through it. If your head uses a box tube this mount is not needed and can be discarded.

3.4 Attach the cylinder mount (LANSS7B03) to the frame as shown.

3. Mount Hydraulic Cylinders

3.5 Install the cylinders (LANHYDCYLC967-A) so that the ports of the two that are on the same side of the header face each other. Make sure the rod end of the cylinders is down. Align top and bottom brackets and tighten all hardware.

Hardware:

2 LANFFCJK
2 LANFWS50
2 LANFOIFO
3/16" x 2.00" Cotter Pin

Note: On 2012 and newer heads the cylinder may require the clevis to be adjusted longer by approximately 1/2". On 2011 and older heads, thread the clevis up onto the cylinder rod approximately 1/2". Verify that the bar can be lifted to the end of the cylinder travel without hitting any part of the head.

4. Install Hydraulics

Refer To Hydraulic Schematic On Next Page

- **4.1** Install 90° hydraulic tee fittings into the rod end port of the cylinders and straight fittings into the barrel end port.
- **4.2** Install one of the 32" hydraulic hoses to each fitting on the hydraulic cylinders and connect the corresponding ports on each side of the header with a tee fitting. Do not tighten either at this time.

Refer To Figure 4.1a & 4.1b

- **4.3** Install 9/16" bulk head fittings onto one end of the ball valves and the 11/16" to 9/16" fitting on the other end. Next install a 90° fitting on the side.
- **4.4** Install the ball valves onto the ball valve bracket (LANSS650BVB) using the ball valve spacers (LANSS650BS) to keep the valve assembly away from the header.

Hardware:

2 LAN1618000 3/8" Nylon Insert Lock Nut

Refer To Figures 4.2

- **4.5** Allow enough slack for ease of hose routing: Using the Valve Mount (LANSS650SVM) as a guide, mark holes on the left side of the feeder house opening to drill through back sheet just below the top beam of corn head.
- **4.6** Use the supplied 3/4" hole saw (LANFCJ9M0) to cut out the two marked holes.
- **4.7** Install valve mount to top header beam as shown in Figure 4.1. Tighten hardware.

4 LAN690830 5/8" Serrated Flange Nut

2 LAN079UBOLT 5" U-Bolt

4.8 Install hydraulic valve to mount as shown in figure 4.2. Tighten all hardware.





4. Install Hydraulics

Refer To Hydraulic Schematic On Previous Page

Refer to Figure 4.3

- **4.9** Use the 60" hoses to connect the tee fittings on the left side cylinders to the 48" hoses via 2 more tee fittings. Attach the 48" hoses to the bulkhead fittings.
- **4.10** Route the two 210" hydraulic hoses from the tee fittings on the left side of the header through the opening underneath the feeder house opening of the corn head to the tee fittings on the right side of the header.
- 4.11 Attach the two 210" hoses to tee fittings on the right side of the header as shown. Secure hoses with supplied Zip Ties (LAN44302) as needed.
- **4.12** Tighten hydraulic fittings and hose ends indexing them as to accommodate the best hose routing.

NOTE:

The selector valves allows the user to select between adjusting stalk stompers or adjusting the deck plates. The operator uses the deck plate adjustment switch for both functions. Once the head is removed from the header cart and in the field, lower the stalk stompers and move the selector valve to the deck plate position. Readjustment of the stalk stompers within the field should not be necessary.



4. Install Hydraulics

Refer To Hydraulic Schematic On Page 18

- **4.13** Supply from the combine will go through either the factory hydraulic block installed on the header, or directly into the supplied 78" hoses and onto the middle port of the supplied handle valves.
- **4.14** Attach the hoses going to the deck plates to the 11/16" Male ORFS x 9/16" Male ORB fittings on one end of the handle valves.
- **4.15** Index hoses and fittings as to allow for the best routing. Tighten all hoses and fittings.

NOTE:

The above instructions should maintain the direction of the deck plate adjustment switch. If this is not the case, swap the 78" hoses that attach to the 90° fittings installed in center valve ports.

If you wish the stalk stompers to operate in the opposite direction with the switch, swap the hoses that attach to the left hand side of the hydraulic valves.

5. Install Center Stalk Stompers

Refer to Figure 5.1

5.1 Attach the brackets (LANSS750FE) to the bottom of the header angle bracket on each side of the feeder house opening. A shim plate (LANSS700I) is provided to lower the toolbar if necessary.

Hardware:

4 LANF1ERQ 1/2" x 2.0" Carriage Bolt 4 LAN3722 1/2" Serrated Flange Nut


2011 & older heads utilize the back center holes on the mount (LAN750FE)

2012 & newer heads utilize the back outer holes on the mount (LAN750FE). Offset the brackets towards the center of the head.

6. Install Center Stalk Stompers

Refer to Figure 6.3

NOTE: For 2011 and older CHOPPING corn heads, remove chopping curtains under feeder house. Reinstall them opposite (backwards) of how they were installed from the factory.

6.2 With the welded tubes facing towards the cab of the combine, mount the tool bar (LANSS6524) to the front of the brackets (LANSS650FE) that were previously installed. Center the bar between the two outside mounts. Tighten the carriage bolts and all the U-bolts on the tool bar at this time.

6. Install Center Stalk Stompers

Refer to Figure 6.4

6.3 Slide the Lankota Stalk Stompers onto the mounts and secure with provided Hitch Pin (LANSS704). Lankota Stalk Stompers can be flipped upside down on the quick disconnect mounts if necessary for clearance during transport.

NOTE:

For any Stalk Stomper shoes that will not be removed frequently, it is recommended that you securely bolt the shoes to the mounts using the supplied 1/2" bolt (LANFNHVK) and lock nut (LANFNXC1).

Stalk Stomper Disclaimer

The most effective use of the Lankota Stalk Stomper® is achieved by adjusting the stomper pad so that when the corn head is at its normal cutting height, the pad of the shoe is 1" above the ground. Over compression of the spring can shorten the life of the stomper spring, increase wear on
