Preparation

- 1. Park the combine on a flat level surface.
- 2. Set the parking brake on the combine.
- 3. Turn off the combine engine and remove the key.

Refer to Figure 1

- 1. Loosen and remove the nuts and bolts shown from one side of the combine.
- 2. Replace with the 5/8" x 3.5" bolts (LANB714) and 5/8" flange nuts (LAN690830). Leave the nuts off.



- 3. Hold the hanger bracket up and install and tighten the new nuts, securing the bracket in place.
- 4. Repeat steps 1-3 on the other side of the combine.

- 5. Lay the (2) tubes on a flat surface and press the open ends together.
- 6. Hook (2) LAN2600UBOLTS around each tubes.
- 7. Set the joining bracket on the tubes and run the U-Bolts through the holes.
- 8. Secure the joining bracket with 5/8" nuts (LAN690830) and tighten

- 7. To prepare for hanging the bars, put (2) carriage bolts through the hanger brackets and then hang a mounting plate on the bolts with a nut (LAN690830) on each.
- 8. Slide the paired tubes under the combine. Lift one end and prop up securely. **Note:** the joining bracket goes on the bottom of the bars.
- 9. Lift opposite end and set into the mounting bracket.
- 10. Insert the other (2) carriage bolts and nuts through the hanger and mounting brackets. Leave them loose.
- 11. Repeat steps 9 and 10 on the remaining side.
- 12. Slide the bars to the desired position making sure the bars are centered and parallel to the axles.





- 13. Set a stinger on the tube on a side. Determine what set of holes will put the stinger end in the desired location.
- 14. Insert a LAN2600UBOLT into a set of holes and secure with a flange nut (LAN690830).
- 15. Align a tighten, then repeat on the other side.
- 16. Cut the abrasive strip into lengths that will fit between the combine and the stinger.
- 17. Remove backing from the abrasive strips and adhere to the top of the bars.
